IMAGES IN TIME

Over the holidays I spent some spare time going through a drawer full of old photos. Photos are not only wonderful to look at but have the unique ability to bring back long forgotten memories, along with the occasional wave of nostalgia, especially when viewed through rose-colored glasses. In my case, some of the photos provided a portal to a simpler era a long time ago when I was a teenager without a care in the world, and my whole life ahead of me.

Being a total gear head, the vast majority of the photos were of cars. I got my start taking photos of new cars on display at the Chicago Auto Show with a 1948 Kodak Box Camera. Too young to have a driver's license in those days, I took the bus to the Auto Show, as it was quite a distance from where we lived. By the mid-1960's, my automotive subjects had changed to race cars at the dragstrip. The Midwest was well-known as "Door Country" in those days, and the most popular cars were Gassers, Super Stocks and early Altered Wheel-Base Cars, which were the forerunners to flip top Funny Cars. I hung out with the older boys and would tag along with them when they went to the track, as they were just old enough to have a drivers license and access to a car.

As I got older, I moved up slowly but surely to better cameras. This enabled me to take high quality photos of cars on display at events like the Bloomington Gold Corvette Show in Illinois, hot rod events such as Street Rodder Magazine Super Run '83 in Las Vegas and at the vintage road races held at Road America in Elkhart Lake, Wisconsin. By the later 1990's, I was fortunate to have the opportunity to work with an incredibly talented group of professional photographers who were shooting covers and features for car magazines such as Hot Rod, Car & Driver, Truckin', Mopar Action, Muscle Mustangs and Fast Fords and many others. Working with them, I learned a myriad of techniques and use them every time I take photos.

Today, in addition to photographing cool cars for print magazine feature stories and digital magazines, I have great fun taking photos at many of the RVCC events, cruises and rod runs, and especially at the Fabulous 50's Charity Car Show. Using what I have learned over the years enables me to present fellow club members cars and trucks to the best effect, while enhancing awareness for the club both locally and nationally. In the future, I hope that someone will look back on these photos with the same fondness I have for those that I took so many years ago.

MEMBER PROSPECTIVE

TOM & DONNA SPENCER'S 1932 FORD 3-WINDOW COUPE

This month's feature car is the purple 1932 Ford 3-window coupe belonging to Tom & Donna Spencer. Our good friend Bob Holmes built this car in 1992. I always admired the car, and told Bob that if he ever decided to sell it, I'd like a shot at it. He replied, "You and a bunch of other guys. Get in line." So I didn't ever expect that it would belong to us. However, when Bob became ill, he decided he wanted the car to go to someone that would drive and enjoy it, and not flip it for a quick profit. He told his wife Georgi, "see if Tom and Donna still want the car". Yes! Even though it was 20 years later, we still wanted our dream car!

The car sports a Gibbon body mounted on an aftermarket frame that's been stretched three inches to accommodate the engine. That engine is the focal point of the car—a 1958 Chrysler 392 Hemi that's dressed to emulate an early racing engine with a 6-71 supercharger case, dual 4-barrel carbs, and Mickey Thompson valve covers. Bob made the adapter to mate the Chrysler engine to the Chevy 700R4 transmission before those adapters were commercially available. The rear end is a Frankland quick change, commonly used in road race cars.

The paint is PPG Purple Night with pinstriping by well-known SoCal striper Bob Bond. The interior is trimmed in gray tweed and it recently got a new headliner and floor mats at Emilio's Upholstery in Grants Pass. Being a 90's build it reflects the trends of the era—shaved door handles, hidden door hinges, digital gauges in a billet aluminum insert, Boyd's steering wheel, etc. The car has worn a couple of different sets of wheels but currently rolls on the classic American Torque Thrust II.

When we bought the car in early 2020, it had been sitting for years and needed some attention to be roadworthy. Fresh gas, new tires, fresh fluids & filters, and a new brake master cylinder & booster got it back on the road. We don't have any plans to update the car, we're going to drive and enjoy it in memory of our buddy Bob Holmes.
